
What did you like about tennis ?

Yes I would have loved to have faced them ! **Rafael Nadal** would have been hell for me, a bit like **Sergi Bruguera**. **Novak Djokovic** would have been complicated, I would compare him to **Andre Agassi**. As for **Roger Federer**, he is the most complete but surely the game I would have liked the most. Like **Pete Sampras** but more complete. I have always been motivated to play the best in the world. Facing a guy who wasn't ranked very high didn't really appeal to me. **I loved playing perf** ! You give me a Rafa, a Nole or a Roger, I'm highly motivated to play them !



What do you think about the future of tennis ?

It's going to be complicated. The Covid 19 changes a lot of things in our lives but I think for the former players it's a bad for a good. They can prepare themselves better and will gain a few more months in the spotlight. The **experience will be essential**, they will certainly be more lucid.

I am a fan of Frances Tiafoe, a very spectacular and generous player. And of course I hope to see the French !
